SCHOOL NEWS

It is with a mixture of emotions that I announce that Mrs Melissa Cairn will be leaving our school. The position of Deputy Principal will no longer be available at our school from next year. This is a staffing decision made by the Department of Education (DOE) due our decrease in student enrolments (ie we now do not meet the threshold/number of enrolments to hold this position). Mrs Cairn would usually be placed by the DOE at another school as Deputy Principal. Instead, Mrs Cairn decided to apply for an alternative position within the DOE. Through a rigorous state-wide open merit selection process she has successfully achieved a position as a Senior Education Officer- Level 2 within the DOE.

Congratulations Mrs Cairn! It is wonderful that she has been recognised and selected for her extensive experience and expertise. Mrs Cairn will be focusing on the introduction of the new syllabus for HSIE across NSW. Over the coming 2 terms Mrs Cairn will transition to her new role. We are fortunate to have been able to secure her to remain at our school part of the time so she can finalise initiatives and help us transition to be an executive team without a Deputy Principal. We will formally farewell Mrs Cairn at the end of this year. I know Mrs Cairn has touched the lives of many children and that she works tirelessly for many of our highest needs students and their families. She will be greatly missed at EHPS.

Every year, Epping Heights Public School participates in the NSW Premier's Reading Challenge.

The Challenge aims to encourage a love of reading for leisure and pleasure in students, and to enable them to experience quality literature. It is not a competition but a challenge to each student to read, to read more and to read more widely.

K-2 Students are completing the challenge during Library lessons.

Year 3 – 6 students need to read 20 books in total. 10 books from the PRC list and 10 personal choice books.

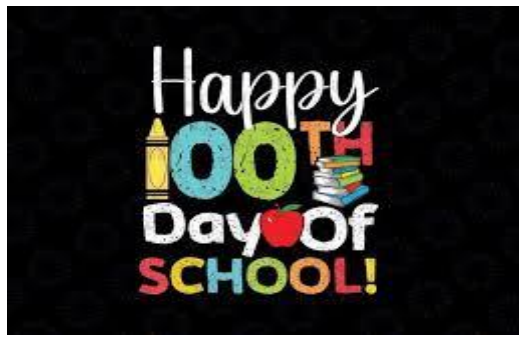

2023 Challenge dates

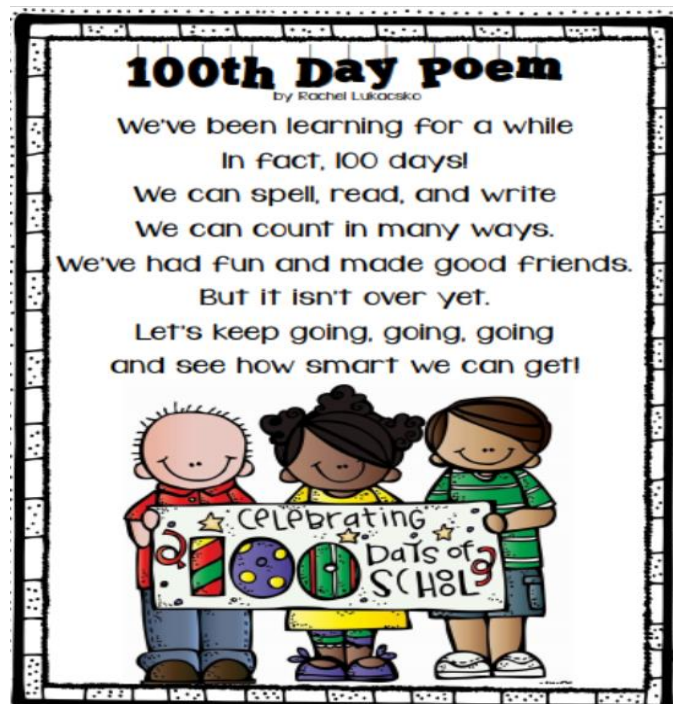
Students can include any books read from the end of the 2022 challenge on their 2023 reading record. Key dates for the 2023 challenge are:

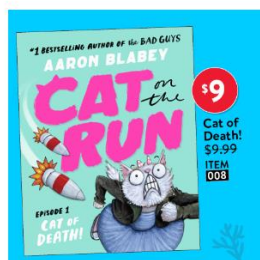
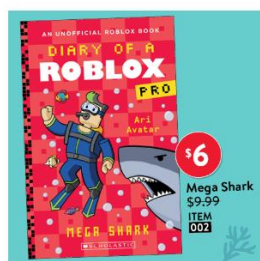
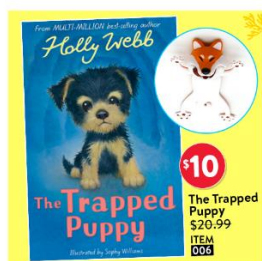
