A MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

It was a delight to celebrate Education Week with special events for our students and families. On Monday last week we held a Kinder tour for new and prospective families for next year. This was well received and children were excited to know they will return for formal Kinder orientation-Term 4. Open Day was an overall huge success. The school was abuzz with excitement as children shared their work, classroom and learning with parents. The day was advertised to parents before the school holidays and again in week 1 of this term with a reminder sent the Friday beforehand. Channels of communication included enews, newsletters, google classroom, posters and the valuable class parent network. As such, it was very well attended. Thank you to all the parents, grandparents and family friends who made the time to come and share the celebration.

Feedback on the day through conversations was highly positive. 75 parents completed the survey with 67% strongly agreeing and 30% agreeing they felt welcomed at our school. Thank you to those parents who took the time to thank staff for their hard work and gave us useful feedback. Special thanks again to my wonderful Education Week committee and extra curricular group teachers for their organisation and leadership.



The P&C is thrilled to announce our upcoming partnership with Muirfield Golf Club, who will be our new service provider for the school canteen. A special shout-out goes to Julia and Flora for their unwavering dedication and relentless efforts in bringing this collaboration to fruition!

Under our current operational model, we rely on the assistance of parent volunteers to facilitate food distribution to our students. As we refine the specifics, here's a brief overview of what's expected from you within the existing framework:

- The canteen will operate three days a week (Monday, Wednesday, and Friday)
- Each day, two parent volunteers will be responsible for receiving food deliveries from the vendor. Duties include organizing the items into designated class baskets and coordinating the pickup of these baskets from the canteen.
- Your time commitment as a volunteer would be approximately one hour around lunch time on the days you volunteer

It's worth noting that our canteen serves a dual purpose: providing nourishing meals to hungry students while generating funds for the school. Your involvement in this initiative is immensely valued. Engaging with our canteen program is a great way to meet new people, gain valuable customer service experience, and enjoy a delicious complimentary lunch!

- Minimum 3 musicians and all must be students of Epping Heights
- At most 1 keyboard/piano allowed in the ensemble
- At least three instruments, which may include one (at the most) keyboard/piano
- Only students can apply (no adult accompaniment)
- The performance to be no longer than 3 minutes

There will be performances from all bands, the string ensemble and the choirs and student ensembles will be selected to complement these.


Please note that a maximum of 10 ensembles will be selected to perform in the concert, and priority will be given to year 5 and 6 ensembles.
