

We are fortunate to have such an engaged community led by our dedicated P & C. The parent WhatsApp groups are designed to support communication between home and school and between parents. They are a positive forum to enable parent connection and social opportunities for children. If you have any questions or concerns about staff, other children or other parents- please bring them to the school directly. The WhatsApp group is not the place to discuss others. By emailing or calling the school directly, we are able to respond accordingly. Thank you for your partnership in ensuring our school community is supportive and positive.

Student safety

We have tree trimming occurring in the school across this weekend. If your child attends one of our community group activities on Saturday or Sunday, please remind them to ensure they stay with the adults in charge at all times.

It has come to my attention that some children are being asked by parents to wait in the afternoon unsupervised in the playground on the equipment. This is not safe. Parents must collect your own child at 3:05p.m or organise after school care via OSHC services or a friend or family member. Parents must supervise their own child if staying on the play equipment after school.

Please ensure you arrive or answer calls (from an unknown number) on time so teachers can stick to their schedule. This will ensure all parents have their allocated time with the teacher. Birthdays and religious celebrations

Family celebrations are a special time. If your child needs to take leave for religious reasons, please apply through school bytes. Birthdays are not included as an acceptable reason for leave. Please celebrate these after school hours. If you wish to send something for your child to share on their birthday or for a special celebration, please send small stationary or play items only (e.g a pencil, ball, eraser etc). These will be given out at the end of the school day for children to take home so parents can make the decision whether to give them to their own child. Please do not send any food items.

Attendance

Consistently going to school has countless benefits – from learning, to creating social connections and improving wellbeing through access to support and quality education.

Students are required to attend school every day, whether it's the first or last day of the term, Mondays, Fridays or days dedicated to sports carnivals, school excursions and incursions.

As we look ahead to the remainder of the school year, I'd like to remind our school community that we are here to work with you to support your child to thrive. We know that families experience a variety of challenging circumstances, and we are committed to working with you to address any barriers to regular attendance.

If your child is absent from school, please let us know why as soon as possible, even if it's just a few minutes at the start or end of the school day. Of course, there will be times when your child is unable to be at school, like when they are unwell. Medical appointments should take place outside school hours where possible, and family holidays should be taken in term breaks.

If your child is feeling anxious about coming to school and you need support, please reach out to your child's teacher or to me directly. There are also helpful resources for parents and carers on the NSW Department of Education website.

Thank you for being a part of our school community and for partnering with us to ensure students access the endless benefits of regular school attendance.
